You Cannot Lead What You Cannot See

Every organisation has pressure it cannot read. It hides in workflow, communication lines, and responsibility gaps. It reshapes behaviour long before it reshapes performance. And by the time it becomes visible, the cost has already been paid.

And it closes with a shift that makes the room feel like they're early to something important.
